Corrinne Davis - Community Engagement

Good afternoon, I would like to introduce myself as the Community Engagement Ranger for the Hampshire County Council Rights of Way Team. I work primarily with parish councils, landowners and volunteers to build a network of contacts with the aim of improving local rights of way. Recently Awbridge 706 (from the B3084 to Cooks Lane), which forms part of the Test Way, has been flagged as needing attention. There is a boardwalk which needs to be upgraded, and a particularly overgrown and slippery section that needs work. There are also several stiles that the council could provide funding to change to more accessible gates. I have reached out to who we believe to be the landowner but haven't heard back from them. I would really appreciate the help of the parish council in planning to upgrade this path, hence contacting you now. I would be happy to meet you on site, or locally in the village in the new year to further discuss these plans and answer any questions you have about the parish rights of way in general.
